General Information

COURSE/PROGRAM EXAMS

To receive credit for a course or to apply the course toward a BOMI International program, students are required to successfully pass an exam (with a 70% or higher) at the end of the course.

With the exception of *Ethics Is Good Business*® *ShortCourse*™, all exams are administered via Computer-Based Testing (CBT) through our testing provider, Pearson VUE, at a secure Pearson VUE owned or authorized location.

COURSE/PROGRAM INSTRUCTORS

All of our instructors are accomplished leaders in property and facility management and undergo an extensive review to ensure they have a high level of technical competence in the subject matter to be taught.

COURSE/PROGRAM LENGTH

Courses range from 24-30 hours and may be taken in the order and via the delivery option you prefer.

The length of a program depends on its requirements, how often a course is taken, and the delivery option. There is no time limit in which you must finish a program.

COURSE/PROGRAM FEES

The total cost of a course/program varies according to the course delivery option, as well as the following.

I Only Want to Take a Course or Courses

Those who take courses without joining a certificate or designation program must pay an Enrollment and a Registration Fee for EACH course taken.

I Want to Earn a Certificate or Designation

The first time you sign-up for a program, you must pay a one time Enrollment Fee for the program and a Registration Fee for the program course you have selected.

I'm Already Enrolled in a Certificate or Designation

After you are enrolled in a program, you will only have to pay a Registration Fee for each additional course needed to complete the program.

Can I apply college credit or work experience toward a BOMI International program?

This depends on the program. Students enrolled in the RPA, FMA, or SMA Designation Programs are eligible to apply for Transfer and Competency Credits. Credits for courses awarded through competency do not qualify for most certificate programs.

Can I apply BOMI International courses toward other continuing education credit?

The US Green Building Council (USGBC) has approved several BOMI International courses for GBCI CE Hours toward the LEED Credential Maintenance Program. Many BOMI International courses have also been approved toward maintaining the CFM, CPM, CCIM, and many other industry credentials.

EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

To earn the RPA Designation, you must have at least three years of verifiable experience as a property manager. This experience must be performed for a portfolio or building 50,000 square feet or larger. Work-related experience must include responsibility in 24 of 33 categories.

Students who enroll in the FMA Designation Program on or after July 1, 2013 are required to demonstrate at least three years of verifiable facilities management experience or equivalent. The experience must be performed for a portfolio or building 50,000 square feet or larger. Work-related experience must include responsibility in 28 of 41 categories.

To earn the SMA Designation, you must have at least three years of verifiable experience as a stationary engineer or equivalent. This experience must be performed for a minimum property portfolio of 40,000 square feet. Work-related experience must include responsibility in 25 of 35 categories.

Each designation has its own Experience Criteria Form, Forms are available on our website.

CPD

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Meeting the requirements of the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Program is an obligation accepted by each BOMI International graduate upon earning the RPA, FMA, or SMA Designation.

Participation in the program helps graduates keep pace with the latest developments while enhancing their career and increasing the professionalism of the entire property and facility management industry.

BOMI International offers a variety of ways for today's busy professionals to earn CPD points, including courses and seminars, real estate license renewal, and industry experiences such as participating in trade associations, publishing an article, or presenting a paper.
